

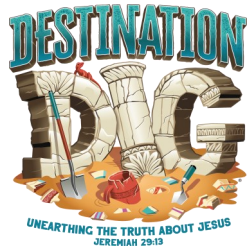

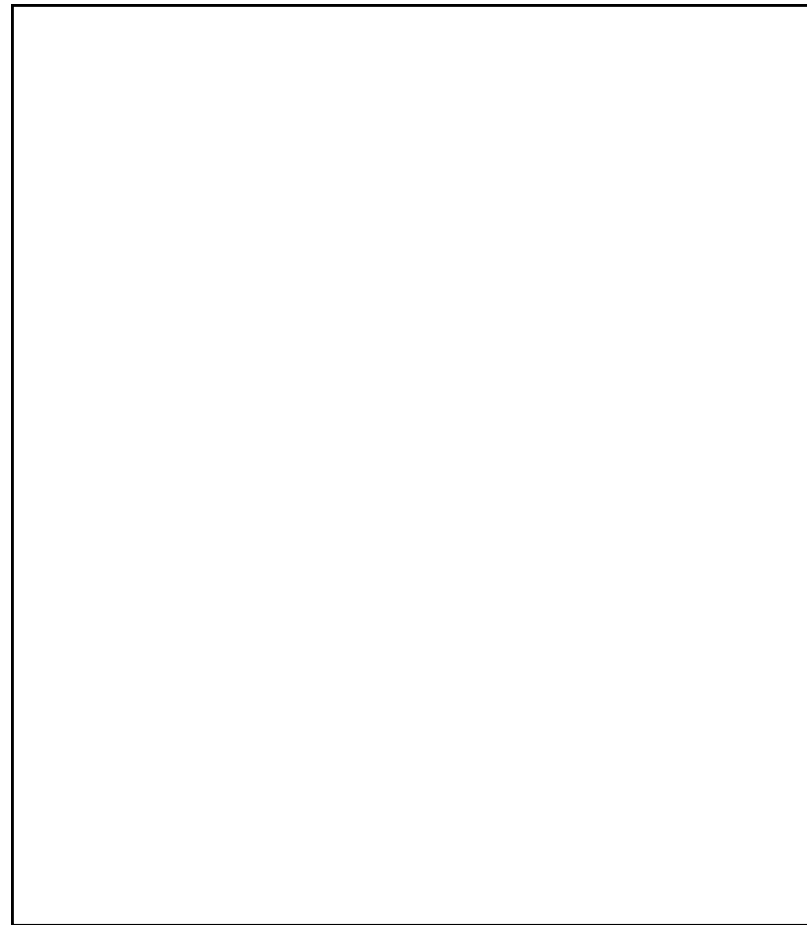

Women's Ministry

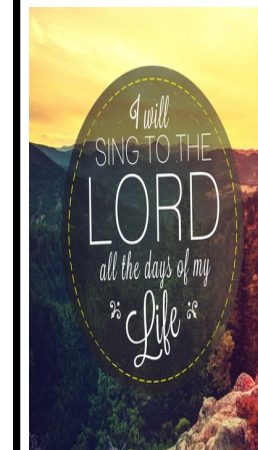
